## SWIMMING POOL: TERMS & CONDITIONS OF USE - 2012

All school staff, including the appointed lifeguards, has the authority to undertake random key checks and to take appropriate action in the event of a breach of these conditions. The role of the lifeguards is primarily to prevent accidents; their authority in carrying out this demanding task is not to be challenged. Staff have the right to request anyone to leave the premises and this decision cannot be challenged. All users of the pool must observe all regulations for the use of the pool from time to time introduced by the School

- **Keys remain the property of the school and are strictly non-transferable.** The reproduction of keys is not possible.
- **No more than four persons (adults or children) may accompany any keyholder who must be present.** The lifeguards will strictly enforce this rule and checks will be made at the gate. If the keyholder (or, in the case of joint key-holders, one of them) is not present then the persons unable to have access to the pool must leave the premises immediately.
- **Security badges** must be produced on entry to swimming pool
- **Pedestrian access is via the gate in Creffield Road. No parking available on school premises. This will be strictly enforced.**
- **No more than 75 people are allowed in the pool at any one time.** Others wishing to use the pool must wait outside the door for admission on a first-come, first-served basis, which will be controlled by the lifeguards.
- No-one must enter the pool or the surrounding area enclosed by the walls if a lifeguard is not present.
- Adults are responsible for the behaviour of the children they accompany.
- No food or drink is allowed in the pool area. The pool area must be kept litter free.
- No animals allowed in the pool area
- The whole of the school site is a non-smoking area.
- Swimmers with long hair must wear a cap. (*Hair and plastic bags block the filter.*)
- Noise must be kept to a minimum.
- Balls, rubber dinghies and the like are forbidden.
- Non-swimmers must be confined to the shallow end, even when wearing swimming aids, and are to be strictly supervised by a vigilant adult.
- Young children and non-swimmers must be accompanied to the lavatory near the deep end.
- Diving must be restricted to the deep end.

**Failure to comply with any of these terms & conditions could result in the key being withdrawn**
