Annual Dinner – Saturday 17th December at 6.30pm

Enclosed is the Notice of the Annual Dinner, to be held at the school on Saturday 17th December, at 6.30pm with the call to dinner at 7pm.

This year we have made the dinner more accessible and relevant to younger OCs, including those who left CRGS this year and those still at University. Of course the traditional theme has been preserved for the benefit of all. Following the outstanding meal served to us last year I am pleased to say Le Talbooth will again be our caterers. For the first time there will be a Champagne Reception, kindly sponsored by Elizabeth Cannon Antiques.

The date selected is the first Saturday after all the Universities finish for Christmas. Please note we will again be offering places at a reduced rate of £20 to the first 20 OCs in full-time University education who apply. The Headmaster has proposed that any OC of more mature years who wishes to subsidise the reduction in ticket price for University students may do so at a cost of £15 per student. This is to be known as the "Headmaster's Initiative". I am sure that any student fortunate enough to benefit from the generosity of such a contribution will want to make their thanks known.

For the first time in the history of CRGS, the school captain is female. I am hoping the appointment of Evie Hampson will encourage lady OCs to attend the Dinner and witness her ground-breaking report.

The traditional rugby match between The Headmaster's XV and the President's XV will be held on the same day, kick off at 2.15pm at the school playing fields. All members are welcome to play or attend. The presentation of the Casey Cup (otherwise known as the Baron's Bowl) will take place to the captain of the winning team during the meal.
